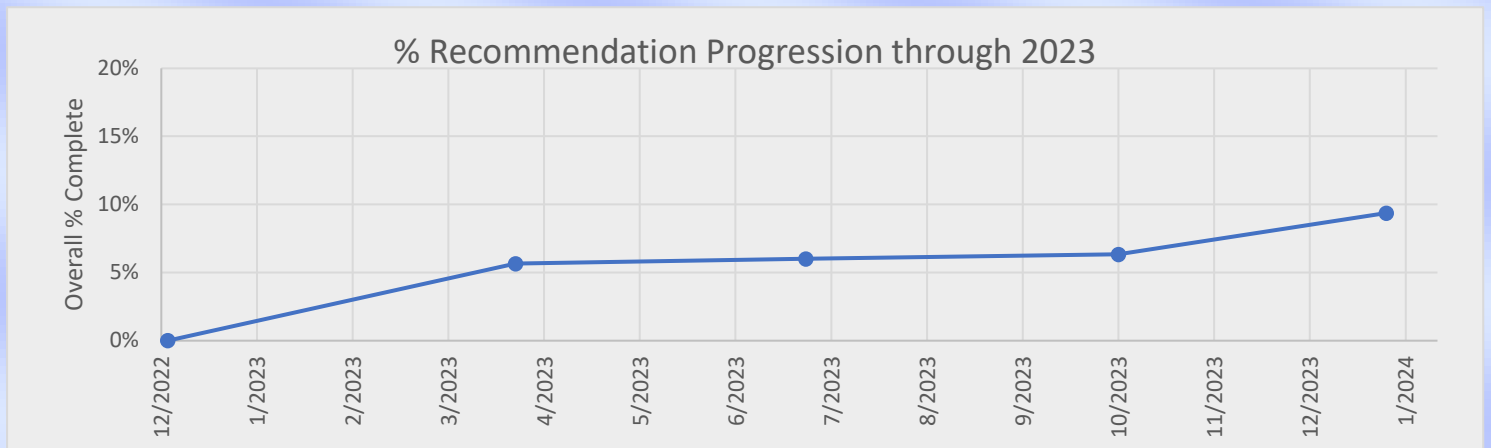

Recommendations Completed This Year

- **Water Use Laws & Regulations #2** – Propose Legislation to regulate water reuse.
- **Navigation #7** – Utilize dredge material in infrastructure Projects.
- **Navigation #10** – Establish IDOT Marine Transportation

Operations of the Task Force

The State Water Plan Task Force met quarterly throughout the year on 1/9/23, 4/10/23, 7/10/23 and 10/16/23. The first three meetings were virtual and an in-person meeting was held in October.

Key Progress

- Integrated Water Management #1 - Establish the Integrated Water Information Center (IWIC): Legislation has been drafted for the developing the center. The structure of the Center is being configured to further refine the details of the center.
- Integrated Water Management #2 - Fund and support State Water Plan Task Force: A bill has been introduced to codify the State Water Plan Task Force.
- Integrated Water Management #6 - the Illinois Environmental Council has introduced the Resilient Illinois Revolving Loan Fund Act that in essence, drives the necessary regeneration and expansion of the IMAG team.
- Water Sustainability #2 - Determine sustainable water yield for all water supply sources and share online: The data sets are near completion. The online application needs to be improved and address the concern of stakeholders.
- Flood Damage Mitigation #1 - Update rainfall data by modeling future/seasonal data changes: Contract is underway with ISWS to develop this data with an expected completion date by the end of 2024.

Further Updates

The State Water Plan Website continues to provide quarterly progress reporting following each Task Force meeting. The progress shows the number of recommendations started, the completion percentage for each and includes progress notes.
