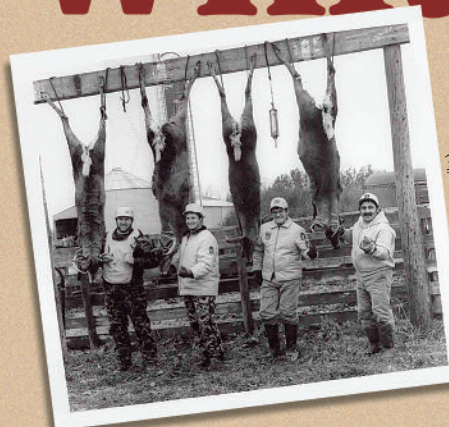


Generations of the Rossi family gather each deer season to share the traditions of the hunt.

# Whitetail Tales

**R**eturning from the service in 1969, Dan Rossi was surprised to learn that deer hunting was open in Montgomery County.

“We’d never seen a deer, or even a deer track, on the family farm, but I decided to give it a try,” Rossi explained while gathered around the dining room table with 10 of his hunting partners listening in, each chiming in with details they recalled from hearing recounts of the hunt. “I shot a 7-point buck with my Hunter’s 60-inch longbow, and then our Dalmatian helped me track it.”

Rossi quickly pointed out that deer hunting has changed considerably in the last 39 years.

“I’ve changed my tactics a lot since those early days,” Rossi continued. “I used to walk all over, but now I just sit in a tree or on the ground.”

But some things remain constant—sharing the sport with the family. More than a dozen family members now gather each deer season at the elder Rossi’s farm.

“I’ve tried to teach the youngsters two things: Safety comes first and killing means something,” Rossi said.

“We’re not doing this for the thrill of the hunt.”

The 11 hunters—ranging in age from 11 to 67—collectively had 210 years of deer hunting experience and had harvested 263 deer. The house was filled with noisy banter about the impressive buck—the largest harvested by any family member—Rory Rossi had harvested that morning, and how each deer stand had earned its name: Brass Factory, Padded Stand, Swamp, Cliff Hanger, Two-Seater, Burlap and Airport.

“Over the years we’ve built enough deer stands to build a house, and helped out the economy considerably,” Fred Rossi said with a chuckle.

“Deer hunting is the best thing in the world and a great way of life,” Dan Rossi said. “It doesn’t matter when the

family gets together—Easter, Thanksgiving or Christmas—we’re always talking deer or turkey hunting. It’s in our blood and we can’t get it out.”



**T**he Big Buck Recognition Program honors deer hunters annually. Qualifying deer taken by firearm and archery hunters are scored by certified measurers after 60 days of drying, with standards set by the Boone and Crockett Club. To qualify, deer taken by firearm must have a minimum score of 140 for a typical rack and 160 for a non-typical rack. For archery and crossbow hunters, the minimum score is 115 for typical and 130 for non-typical antlers.
