Land-based Water Trail Sign (recommended)



18" x 24" aluminum sign and mounting equipment for placement in parking lots, roadways leading to access site, etc.).

Water Trail Access Site Windsock (recommended)



Windsock setup comes with one 24" x 60" windsock/flag (orange and white striped with Lake Michigan Water Trail logo, actual flag may differ from mock-up pending final designs), windsock mounting kit, and one 16' telescoping fiberglass pole to insert into ground or beach.
