NOTE: As part of a crew you must be able to be away from home and work for at least 18 days. A crew will consist of 20 people. You are expected to carry out your duties as directed. You are expected to follow the chain of command.

If you do not have wildland training and/or experience you may still apply. However, you are required to complete the minimum training, NWCG S130, S190, I-100, I-700 and a field day and successfully complete the work capacity/pack test prior to mobilization. To get a better understanding of this program review the Wildland Fire Crew Ops Manual and Fire Policy. Crew assembly is dependent on national fire activity, number of firefighters available, specific qualifications needed and IDNR's ability to post a crew.

If you are not an Illinois State employee, you will be considered an A.D. (Administratively Determined) employee. An AD is a temporary emergency employee for the USDA Forest Service. While IDNR be your supervisor and manage your records, training, experience, and red carding the Forest Service will pay your salary, expenses, and travel. As an AD you will have a package of paperwork to be completed prior to wildfire mobilization. The current pay rate for a Firefighter Type 2 (entry level wildland firefighter) is \$21.08/hr. You can typically expect 12 to 16 hours per day.
