### 5) <u>Status of Certification of Prescribed Burn Manager Process</u>

Tom Wilson reported that applications for PBMs were up by a count of 30 - 40 from last year but that he hadn't been in the building to know an exact number. He will send out an email to the group when he can get the exact number.

We are still receiving some letters of recommendation rather than the task book but Tom is taking care of that.

There has been an issue with it taking too long to process applications. The Forestry Division is making changes to the workflow to speed up the process

The position for Tom's replacement has been posted but there is no estimated date for filling his position.

All present introduced themselves except Kelly Neal - INPC, because of audio issues.

Mike Wefer reported that last year we had voted to make the recommendation to Director Callahan to change the rules to be able to enforce the administrative rules however, several questions must be answered in order to move forward with the administrative rule: Do we have the capacity to enforce it? Who would enforce it – OLE or would we do it administratively? Do we need to set up a system for how violations are reported and how will we do investigations? How will we define and what will the threshold for personal injury be and what will threshold and definition of property damage be? How do we enforce failure to complete burn reports? How do we enforce fraud or misrepresentation in applications and how will re-instatement work? If we want to make some of it criminal, then we may have to revise the statute itself.

Mike Wefer noted that we have the time to get this right.

Tom Gargrave stated that what concerns him most is that our prescribed burn policy is woefully out of date. Tom went on to say that he does have a small group looking at the policy.

Jack Pizzo stated that only a few instances of bad behavior had been observed and he concurred with Mike Wefer that we should take the time to get things right in reference to rule changes.

It was moved by Jack Pizzo, seconded by Tom Wilson and carried to investigate the administrative rules of other states as well as to answer questions regarding enforcement,

### 7) Enforcing the Administrative Rule/Revoking Certification

Tom Gargrave stated that burn managers receive training from various sources that differ in quality and so we are very weak in our sponsorship of what "training" really means.
