

MORAINES HILLS STATE PARK

This inventory was prepared by Margo Milde for Moraine Hills State Park, including Kettle Moraine Nature Preserve.

All elements were personally observed by me in the year ending August 1, 1997.

The first line for each element includes the scientific (Latin) name, a common name, and family. Unless otherwise noted, all names are as listed in the 1994 edition of Plants of the Chicago Region by Floyd Swink and Dr. Gerould Wilhelm. Additionally, each taxon is given a wetland category, and a number representing the "coefficient of conservatism", as given in the current Swink/Wilhelm flora. Names are arranged alphabetically by scientific name.

The second line for each element contains my personal observation places/dates for Moraine Hills. I've noted my comments on habitats where each element is most likely to be found in the Park, as well as the frequency that I noticed each element in the park. Obviously, for the more common elements, I simply could not list each occurrence in the Park. Others were only noted once or twice. These are therefore reflected in the frequency of occurrence I gave each element in the list. I did not include elements deliberately planted or introduced in recent years. However, I did include naturalized old plantings and escapes.

For practical purposes, sites where each element was noted are generally abbreviated in the list. A list of abbreviations follows. As I was asked to focus on several areas in particular in the Nature Preserve, and the Park, those abbreviations appear more frequently in the list. These abbreviations represent areas in the Nature Preserve (Pike Marsh, Leatherleaf Bog, Upland Woods West of Leatherleaf Bog, Leatherleaf Bog Moat, Lake Defiance Boardwalk, and Marshes Northwest of Lake Defiance) and areas of current or previous restoration work (Sedge Meadow South of River Road, Marsh North of Hickory Ridge parking lot, Upland Woods near Whitetail Trail Junction), as well as an area of special interest (Floating Mat and Fen on Southeast portion of Lake Defiance.)
