Archery Season Dates

October 1, 2025 - January 18, 2026, in Cook, DuPage and Lake counties, and that portion of Kane County east of State Route 47

In all other counties and that portion of Kane County west of State Route 47, archery season dates are October 1, 2025 - January 18, 2026, **except archery deer hunting is closed for the Firearm Deer Seasons** November 21 - 23, 2025 and December 4 - 7, 2025.

Archery deer hunting is **open** during the following seasons:

Muzzleloader-Only	December 12 - 14, 2025
Youth Firearm	October 11 - 13, 2025
Late Winter	Jan. 1 - 4, 2026 & Jan. 16 - 18, 2026
CWD	Jan. 1 - 4, 2026 & Jan. 16 - 18, 2026

Application Information: Applications for a Resident Either-Sex Archery Deer Permit are accepted as soon as the application is available until the last day to apply, September 1. Each individual is limited to one single either-sex archery permit through the mail from the Permit Office. Incomplete or incorrect applications will be returned.

Illinois Restricted Archery Zone: During the period October 1 - October 31, only antlered deer may be harvested in the Restricted Archery Zone, regardless of permits in possession. IDNR is currently considering changes to this zone. Please consult the 2025-2026 Hunting and Trapping Digest for details.

Over-the-Counter Permits: Archery deer permits will be available over the counter from license vendors beginning August 1.
