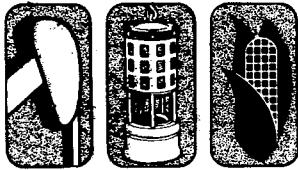

SUBJECT: Coal Exploration Notice Requirements

Section 1772.11 of the Department's permanent program rules and regulations requires a written notice of intention to explore be filed with the Department prior to conducting the exploration. Section 1772.11(b) details the information that shall be included in each notice of intent. Regulations state that the notice shall contain a copy of a fully executed Form OG-14-A or Form OG-14-B which were available from the Oil and Gas Division of the Department. The Oil and Gas Division recently changed to a new form for test hole permits, Form OG-7, and the OG-14 forms are no longer applicable.

Those operators planning exploration drilling are required to submit a Form OG-7 for each Section to be explored to the Oil and Gas Division. Effective February 1, 1990, the Department requires a permit fee of \$100.00 per Section be submitted to the Oil and Gas Division. In addition, the operator must have a \$25,000.00 blanket surety bond on file with the Oil and Gas Division. A copy of the fully executed OG-7 shall be submitted to the Land Reclamation Division with the written notice of intent in lieu of the OG-14 forms. Copies of revised forms are attached.

Underground mine access holes (powerline holes, ventilation and other service holes) do not require a permit from the Oil and Gas Division. Access holes will be permitted by the Land Reclamation Division.

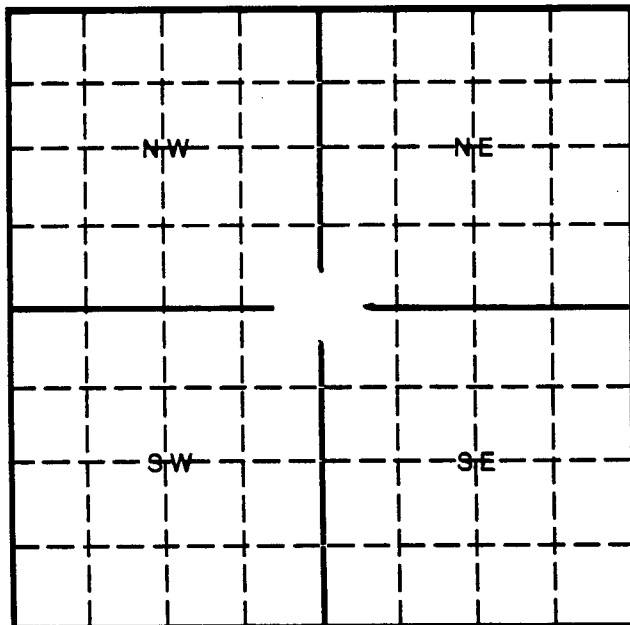

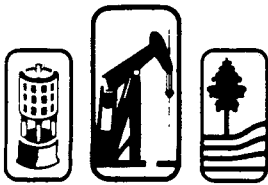
SHOW PROPOSED LOCATION OF EACH TEST HOLE ON PLAT
