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ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEWS COMPLETED

Project reviews completed from May 16 to June 15 are listed below. These projects have been screened through the internal environmental review process for potential impacts on wetlands, threatened and endangered species, and cultural and archaeological resources, etc. Through the review process it was determined that environmental impacts have been kept to a minimum and mitigated as necessary, that they do not meet the criteria for significant actions as defined in the environmental review process, and may proceed. All these projects are in compliance with the Endangered Species Protection Act, Natural Areas Preservation Act, Interagency Wetlands Policy Act and cultural resource statutes.

- **Illinois Beach State Park**
2413100—This project will permit a study to be conducted of hydrology, water quality, and botanical characterization to guide coastal wetland restoration and management of the site. Project originally submitted for review on 4-12-2024.
- **Goose Lake Prairie State Natural Area**
2414953—This project will permit soil core sampling for a forthcoming park roads project. Project originally submitted for review on 5-15-2024.
- **Banner Marsh State Fish & Wildlife Area**
2213972—This project will remove and replace an existing CMP culvert at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 6-05-2022.
- **Nauvoo State Park**
2414258—This project will complete the stabilization of the Veranda/Porch at the Rheinberger House at the site. Project submitted for review on 5-03-2024.
- **Pere Marquette State Park**
2414975—This project will replace 7 parking lot light poles at the Visitor Center at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 5-15-2024.
- **Mt. Vernon Game Farm**
2414989—This project will dredge the trout pond at the site to promote the fishery and improve habitat. Project originally submitted for review on 5-15-2024.
- **Stephen A. Forbes State Park**
2414057—This project will permit directional bore under the site to access privately owned minerals without ground disturbance on IDNR. Project originally submitted for review on 5-01-2024.
- **Silver Springs State Fish & Wildlife Area**
2413323—This project will involve replacement of the roof on the tenant house at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 4-17-2024.
- **Clinton Lake State Recreation Area**
2302570—This project will make improvements to the west side boat access area at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 8-11-2022.
- **Illinois Beach State Park**
2415540—This project will install a sign explaining the shoreline stabilization project and acknowledging an excellence award. Project originally submitted for review on 5-29-2024.
- **Rock Cut State Park**
2415849—This project will permit installation of a memorial bench at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 6-04-2024.
- **Middle Fork State Fish & Wildlife Area**
2415900—This project will consist of framing and enclosing an open portion of the horse barn at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 6-04-2024.
- **Green River State Fish & Wildlife Area**
2405966—This project will replace the roof on the maintenance building at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 5-29-2024.
- **Callahan House**
2414949—This project will repair a historic door on the Callahan House. Project originally submitted for review on 5-15-2024.

- **Johnson-Sauk Trail State Recreation Area**
2409334—This project proposes repairs to the historic Ryan's Round Barn at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 4-30-2024.
- **Stephen A. Forbes State Park**
2414973—This project will dredge the pond and demolish the barn at the horse camp at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 5-15-2024.
- **Frank Holten State Park**
2416325—This project will install safety cameras at site entrances. Project originally submitted for review on 6-10-2024.

- **Johnson-Sauk Trail State Recreation Area**
2416549—This project will repair, or relocate in vicinity, a well at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 6-12-2024.
