## ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEWS COMPLETED

Project reviews completed from April 16 to May 15 are listed below. These projects have been screened through the internal environmental review process for potential impacts on wetlands, threatened and endangered species, and cultural and archaeological resources, etc. Through the review process it was determined that environmental impacts have been kept to a minimum and mitigated as necessary, that they do not meet the criteria for significant actions as defined in the environmental review process, and may proceed. All these projects are in compliance with the Endangered Species Protection Act, Natural Areas Preservation Act, Interagency Wetlands Policy Act and cultural resource statutes.

- **Jim Edgar Panther Creek State Fish & Wildlife Area**  
2413289—This project will permit oak plantings at questing hills. Project originally submitted for review on 4-17-2024.
- **Sangchris Lake State Park**  
2412677—This project proposes to install EV charging stations at Hickory Point. Project originally submitted for review on 4-04-2024.
- **Shabbona State Park**  
2410140—This project will permit the replacement of the fence areas around the restaurant at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 4-16-2024.
- **Sangchris Lake State Park**  
2413264—This project made repairs to a waterline leak at the Deer Run pump out station on an emergency basis. Project submitted for review on 4-16-2024.
- **Sam Dale Lake Conservation Area**  
2413243—This project will permit installation of fiber optic lines in the campground. Project originally submitted for review on 4-16-2024.
- **Silver Springs State Fish & Wildlife Area**  
2413106—This project will permit a flag pole installation at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 4-12-2024.
- **Randolph County Conservation Area**  
2413258—This project will install EV charging station at the concession area. Project originally submitted for review on 4-16-2024.
- **Hanover Bluff**  
2412433—This project will involve gravel improvements to a current dirt access road. Project originally submitted for review on 4-01-2024.
- **Eagle Creek State Park**  
2413333—This project will permit construction of a shelter at the Golf Pro Shop. Project originally submitted for review on 4-17-2024.
- **Pullman State Historic Site**  
2413623—This project will make repairs to the porch deck at Hotel Florence. Project originally submitted for review on 4-23-2024.
- **Fox Ridge State Park**  
2407569—This project will resurface approximately 0.6 miles of trails at the existing canoe access connector trail. Project originally submitted for review on 12-05-2023.
- **Fort Massac State Park**  
2413394—This project will install EV charging stations at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 4-18-2024.
- **Silver Springs State Fish & Wildlife Area**  
2405966—This project will demolish two old residences at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 10-20-2023.
- **Pere Marquette State Park**  
2210395—This project proposes to replace the roofing system at the lodge. Project originally submitted for review on 3-08-2022.

- **Middle Fork Fish & Wildlife Area**  
2409334—This project proposes to construct a new wetland at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 1-23-2024.
- **Wayne Fitzgerald State Recreation Area**  
2413821—This project will remove an old underground storage tank at the resort. Project originally submitted for review on 4-26-2024.
- **Mississippi River State Fish & Wildlife Area**  
2413887—This project will replace elements of the Helmbold pump station. Project originally submitted for review on 4-29-2024.
- **Nauvoo State Park**  
2414012—This project will replace the roof of the Sidney street shelter at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 4-30-2024.
- **Middle Fork Fish & Wildlife Area**  
2414252—This project will make repairs to an agricultural drain tile at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 5-03-2024.
- **Middle Fork Fish & Wildlife Area**  
2414550—This project will permit black locust removals for a chainsaw course. Project originally submitted for review on 5-08-2024.
- **Nauvoo State Park**  
2414249—This project will rehabilitate a maintenance garage at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 5-03-2024.
- **Sangchris Lake State Park**  
2414453—This project will clear invasives for trail use and habitat improvement on the west end. Project originally submitted for review on 5-07-2024.
- **Jim Edgar Panther Creek State Fish & Wildlife Area**  
2414547—This project will permit a large fire break to be cleared at various locations at the site to support vegetation management and access. Project originally submitted for review on 5-08-2024.
- **Dana Thomas House State Historic Site**  
2414746—This project will make repairs to the roof drainage system at the Carriage house. Project originally submitted for review on 5-10-2024.
