## Illinois Department of Natural Resources Office of Oil and Gas Resource Management High Volume Horizontal Hydraulic Fracturing Application Second Notice August 4, 2017

On May 22, 2017, the Department of Natural Resources, Office of Oil and Gas Resource Management (Department) received an application from Woolsey Operating Company, LLC, 125 N. Market St., Suite 1000, Wichita, KS 67202 and e-mail address: <a href="mailto:woolsey@woolseyco.com">woolsey@woolseyco.com</a> for a permit under the Hydraulic Fracturing Regulatory Act. The application has been assigned a review number of **HVHHF-000001**.

The well to be known as **Woodrow #1H-310408-193** is proposed be permitted for the production of gas, located at Lat: 38.1343680, Lon -88.3603830, 1990' South and 1650' West of the NEc NE, in Section 31, Township 4 South, Range 8 East, White County, Illinois.

The public hearing for the application mentioned above was held at the Enfield United Methodist Church Family Life Center, Corner of West Main and South Jennette St., Enfield, IL 62835 on August 2, 2017.

When a public Hearing is conducted under Section 245.270, the Department shall provide an additional public comment period to allow for comments in response to evidence and testimony presented at the hearing. This period shall begin on the day after the close of evidence at the public hearing and last for no more than 15 days, taking into consideration that the Department shall have no more than 60 days from the date it receives the permit application to approve or reject the permit application. The comments may be filed in the manner described below.

The second public comment period begins at 8:30 a.m. Central Standard Time on **August 4, 2017**. All public comments must include the **review number** assigned by the Department to the permit application and be received by the Office of Oil and Gas Resource Management no later than 5:00 p.m. Central Standard Time on **August 18, 2017** to be eligible for Department consideration during the permit review process. The comments in this second period *shall be limited to responses to evidence and testimony presented at the hearing*.
