## REPORT PROBLEM IMMEDIATELY TO THE CAMPGROUND HOST, PARK STAFF OR PARK OFFICE.

- 1. Reservations are made online at http://camp.exploremoreil.com/ and must be made at least 3 days prior to your arrival date. Sites not reserved will be considered first-come, first-serve. Picnic Shelters, Amphitheaters and Group Camps can also be reserved online.
- 2. From May 1 September 30, the **maximum length** of stay for a camping party and/or the camping unit is limited to 14 nights within any 30-day period.
- 3. You must have your camp shelter with you to **obtain a campsite**. Camp shelter must be set up at time of registration.
- 4. A "family" consists of either or both parents and unmarried minor children (18 yrs. or younger) – NO MULTIPLE FAMILIES PER CAMPSITE. A "single group" consists of 4 unrelated adults (18 yrs. or older) – NO CHILDREN. A group of no more than four (4) occupants may occupy up to two tents on a single campsite. A "family" may have either two tents or a trailer and one tent for children. Each "family" must occupy separate campsites.

- 5. Checkout time is 3:00 PM daily.
- 6. Visitors must leave the park before 10:00 PM.
- 7. Pets are welcome as long as they are on a leash, not to exceed 10' and under specific physical control at all times. Do not leave your pets unattended. Cleaning up after pets is the responsibility of each owner. Pets are not allowed in shower building facili-
- 8. Please observe quiet hours: 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM; radios, televisions, generators and voices must be kept at a level not to disturb other campsites.
- 9. Please do not park on the grass or park excess vehicles on vacant sites. Do not chain, nail, screw or otherwise attach anything to any tree.
- 10. Alcohol is prohibited in the tent camping area, backpack sites, Long Point Youth Group Camp and Black Locust Group Camp.

## TO AVOID AMPERAGE OVERLOAD, PLEASE USE <u>EITHER</u> 30 AMP <u>OR</u> 20 AMP OUTLET, NOT BOTH. OCCUPANTS OF 50 AMP SITES – PLEASE DO NOT USE ALL AVAILABLE OUTLETS AT SAME TIME.

Class A Sites 2 – 78 electric - \$20/night

Class B/S Sites 79 - 82 vehicle access (no electricity) - \$10/night

Class C Tent sites T1-T10 AND Backpack sites B1-B6 walk-in tent only sites - \$8/night

**Group Camp** YOUTH \$2/person per night (min. fee of \$20/night)

ADULT/FAMILIES - \$4/person per night (min. fee of \$40/night)

Camping fee discounts are available for Illinois Residents: Senior Citizen/Disabled/Disabled Veteran/POW. A \$10 camping fee increase will be charged on holiday weekends for Class AA and Class A campsites, effective Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights of the Memorial Day and Labor Day weekends; and on Friday, Saturday and Sunday night of the Independence Day holiday weekend if July 4th falls on a Friday, Saturday, Sunday or Monday.)
