All programs provided by the Illinois Department of Natural Resources are free of charge; however, groups consisting of 20 or more individuals must pay an Activity Permit Fee of \$25 to the IDNR.

Hikes will take place over trails of up to 1.5 miles, featuring multiple staircases, excluding the Low Impact options mentioned below.

The Low Impact options will cover a distance of up to a mile or less and will not include any staircases.

Each interpretive hike will have a duration of 1.5 hours.

The On and Off-Site program options listed below will last for 30 to 45 minutes.
