

CRITERIA/SUBJECT:

- North American animals, plants, parks, and landscapes. See categories on the last page.

QUANTITY:

- 2 photo entries per photographer.

NOT ALLOWED/DISQUALIFIED:

- Any item not related to the categories listed on the last page.
- Non-Native animals and plants. exotic animals and plants.
- Image enhancement must be limited to minor adjustments.
- Finished entry must still appear to be a photograph, not an artistic impression or design.
- No string, wire, metal sawtooth hangers, or metal hangers allowed.

SIZE:

- Total size of entry cannot exceed 11x14 inches.
- Weight: not to exceed 3 pounds.

FRAMING:

FRAMES NOT ALLOWED!
Only mat boards.



HANGING MECHANISM:

- The only hanging mechanism allowed is the one shown below.
- The sawtooth section must be seen hanging out above the edge of the mat board or photo and centered.
- Plastic sawtooth sticky hangers. Can be found at Hobby Lobby or Online.



ATTACHED TO EACH PHOTO:

- All entries must have a copy of the completed entry form taped securely (all sides) to the back.
