- 1. Instruments are restricted to hand carried devices, small pen knives, ice-picks, and screwdrivers of reasonable size.
- 2. No shovels, picks or entrenching devices of any size shall be used.
- 3. Upon completing detection activity, the permittee must return the work area to its original state.
- 4. All refuse is to be disposed of in proper receptacles.
- 5. At the discretion of the Site Superintendent, detecting may be prohibited due to weather conditions.
