Known as a fisherman's delight, Argyle Lake State Park has a full complement of recreational opportunities. Just 7 miles from Macomb, Argyle Lake offers picnicking, camping, hiking and boating facilities in a scenic, natural setting. With its 93-acre lake for boating and fishing, 5 miles of rugged foot trails through luxuriant virgin forests and full-service campgrounds, this heavily wooded, 1,700-acre site is the ideal place to spend a day, a weekend or longer. For equestrian enthusiasts Argyle Lake offers a rugged, 7-mile equestrian trail and equestrian campground.

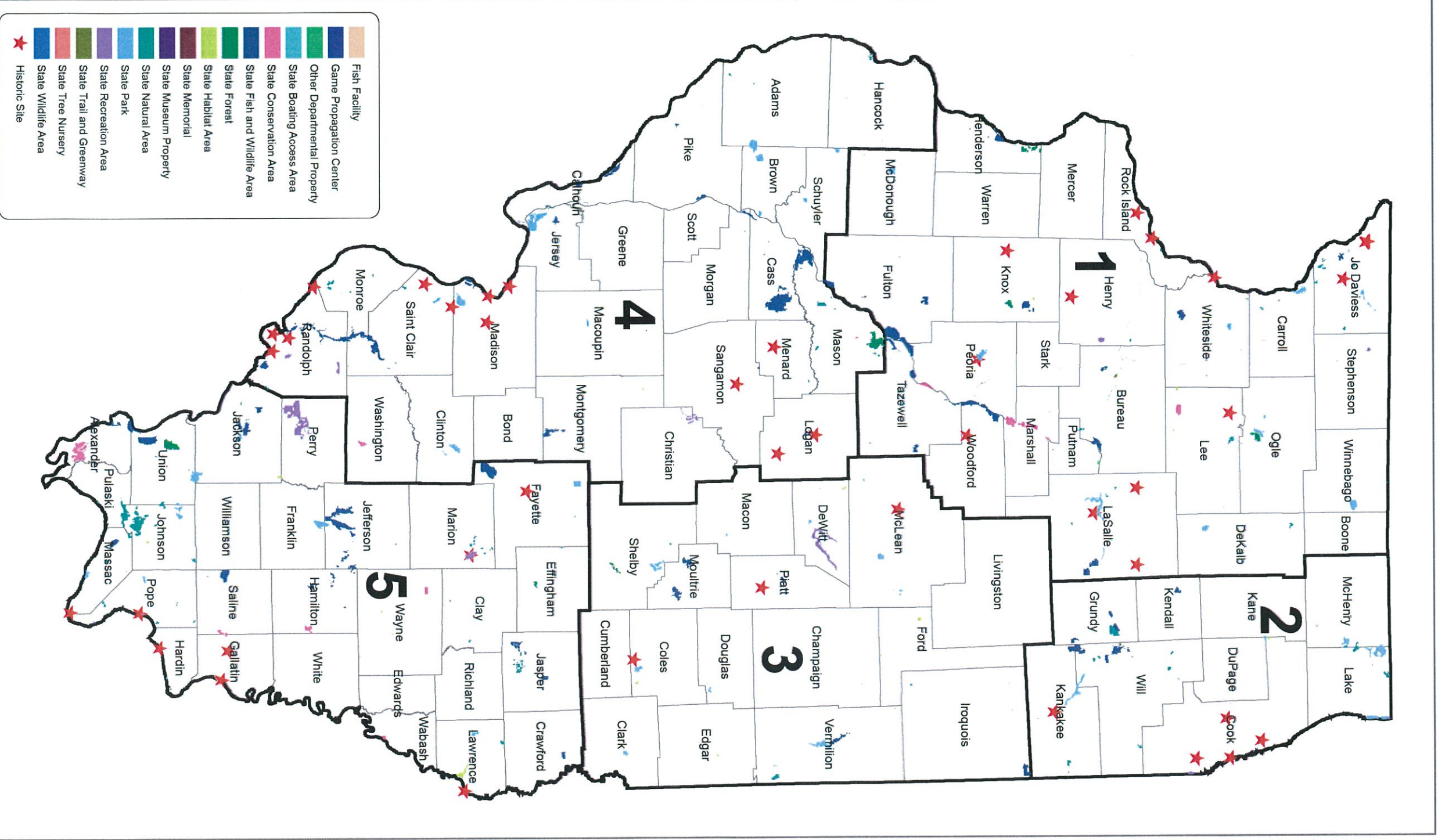
Pictured on the cover is a section of Argyle Lake State Park, located in McDonough County. The former “Teel Property” was acquired June 2018 and adds to existing bottomland forest habitat along the Lamoine River within the park. The 10.2-acre subject property eliminated an in-holding within Argyle Lake State Park, improving trail and boundary lines within the park.
