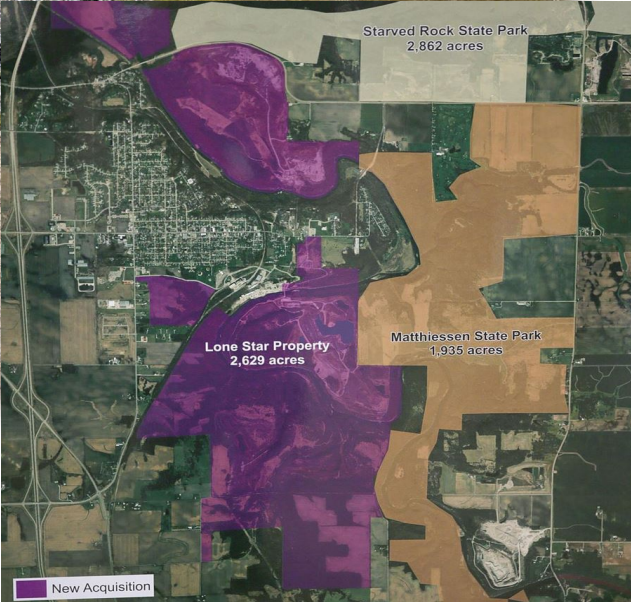

## On The Cover

On October 25, 2018, IDNR finalized the acquisition of 2,629 acres of property in LaSalle County, adjacent to IDNR's Starved Rock and Matthiessen State Parks.

This \$11,050,000.00 purchase from Lone Star Industries, Inc., through the state's Open Land Trust Funds, will protect natural resources and expand recreation opportunities, tourism and economic development near Starved Rock and Matthiessen State Parks. The acquisition conforms to the objectives of the Open Land Trust Program "to protect lakes, rivers, streams, open space, natural lands, wetlands, prairies, forests, watersheds, resource rich areas, greenways, exiting forest preserves, conservation areas, and nature preserves; and additions to such existing public areas."

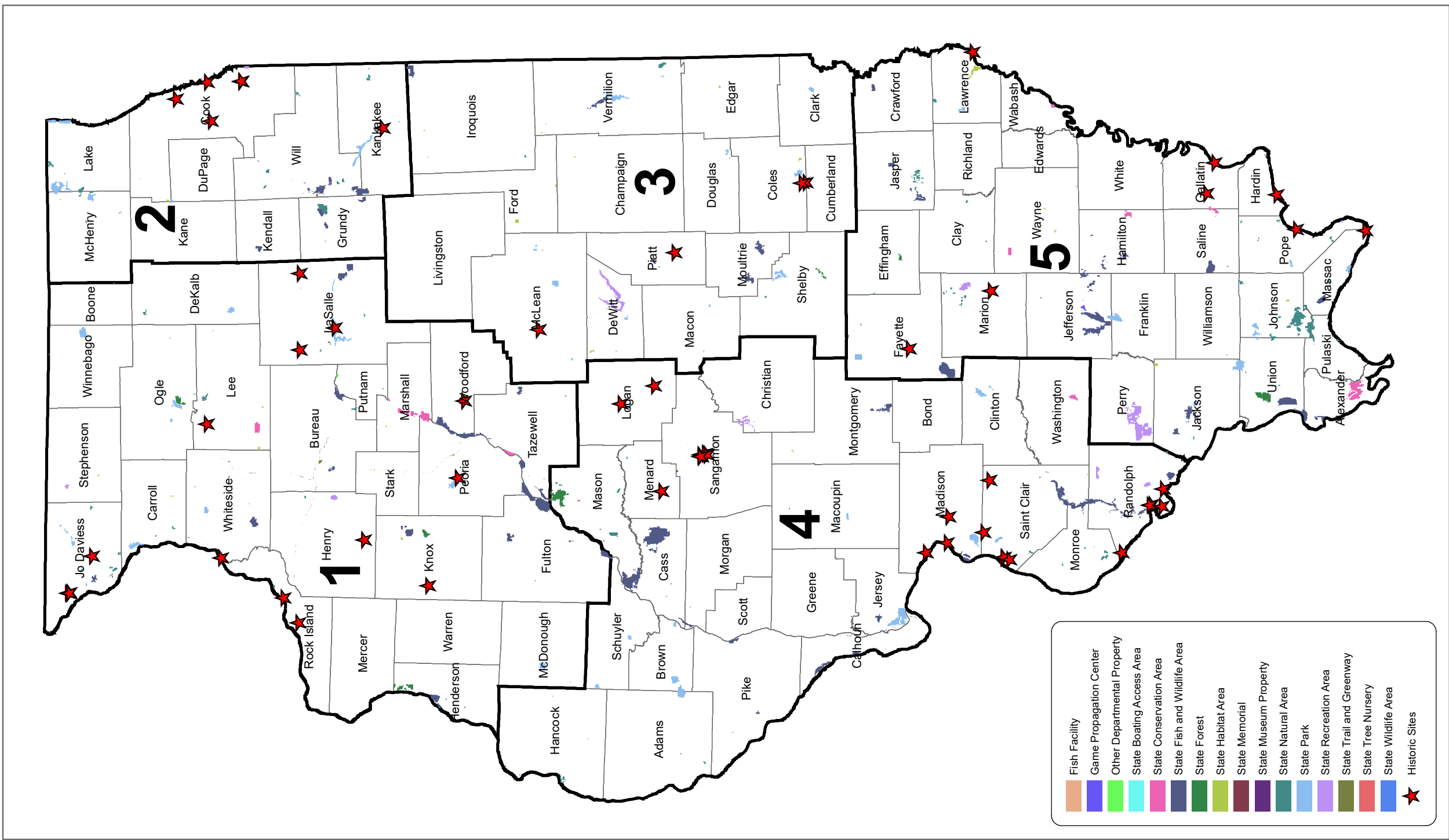
"Step Falls", pictured on the front cover, is one of the most beautiful areas IDNR plans to restore and open to the public in the future. Additionally, the Vermilion River is a major attraction for the area. Many recreational opportunities exist, including canoe/kayak access, bank fishing, hiking trails, equestrian and/or mountain bike trails, day-use picnicking, wildlife watching and hunting programs.
