October 2022, the Pedersen family contacted IDNR, with an interest to donate land to the Department. The family wished to “protect the land in perpetuity for its ecological value and wildlife habitat, water quality and as an aesthetic asset to the local community.”

The property is part of the “Chain O’ Lakes” system. Most of the donation consists of wetlands/water, including an “island” surrounded by cattails, an important habitat for wetland dependent birds and for maintaining water-quality. Trees on the 32-acre island are unique and very large, including large bur oak, white and red oak trees. The dry-mesic forest also includes numerous shagbark hickories in the overstory.

There are several vernal ponds on the island with associated forest canopy openings. The ponds are only wet for a portion of the year and are breeding habitat for amphibians, such as frogs and salamanders.

Acquisition of this donation helps further the Mission of IDNR.

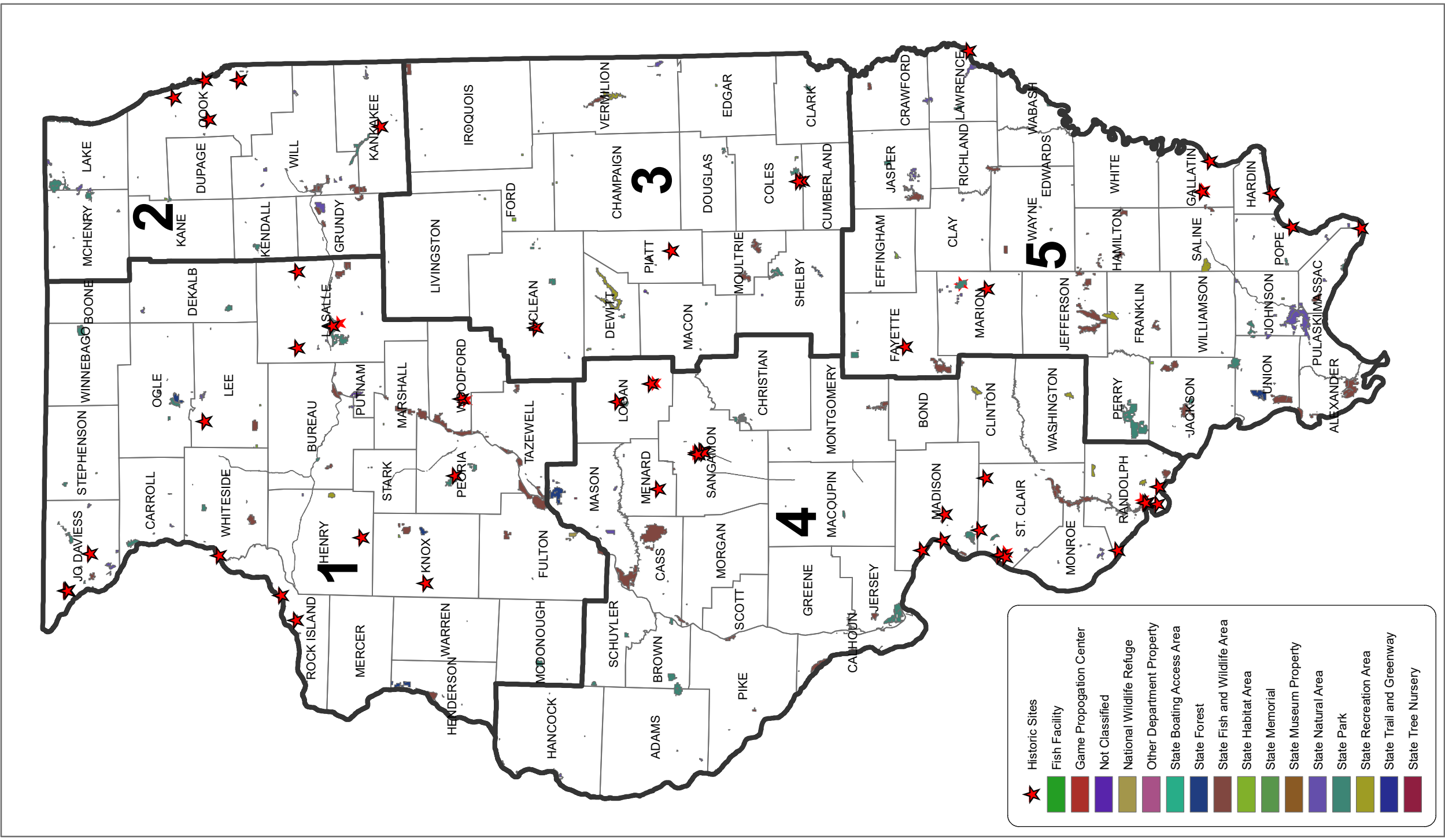
The property was donated by the Pedersen family, will be managed under Land Management, and will eventually be registered as a Land & Water Reserve.
