Registration for the Wingshooting Clinic at Jim Edgar Panther Creek SFWA on **Saturday, June 8, 2024** and **Sunday, June 9, 2024**, is done through the "Click here to register!" link on the IDNR <u>Wingshooting Calendar Page</u>. There is a \$10.00 registration fee per participant for the clinic, as the registration fee is used to help with the cost of the clinic, to include all shotgun shells, targets, and lunch. 28 gauge shotguns, and eye and ear protection are provided.

If you've accessed this registration packet, you've likely already purchased your tickets through the Eventbrite event registration page. If you *have not* already registered and paid online, please do so before submitting your form(s). Complete a Skill Level Assessment form and Participant Permission form for each participant. The permission form must be signed by a parent/guardian for any participant under 18 years of age.

A fact sheet with information that you will need to review is also attached below. The completed form(s) should be sent as early as possible but must be received no later than Wednesday, June 5th. Your registration is not completed until you've registered each participant on the Eventbrite webpage, and you have submitted the completed form(s). JIM EDGAR PANTHER CREEK SFWA WINGSHOOTING CLINIC INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS

SPECIAL NOTES:

- Participants must be 10 years of age or older, and at least 4 feet 6 inches tall and weigh 75 pounds or more to register.
- Introductory Wingshooting Clinics are designed for beginning and novice shotgun shooting students.
 Participants must legitimately be in either the "Never" or "Rarely" skill level to enroll in these clinics.
 Prospective participants with shooting skills beyond the novice level should consider registering for a Hunter's Wingshooting Clinic.
- The Department of Natural Resources, the Safety Education Instructor, or the Wingshooting Instructor will remove any participant from the Wingshooting Clinic for disruptive or unsafe behavior.
- Wingshooting Clinics do not satisfy the Illinois Hunter Education Requirement.

DATES AND TIMES: Saturday, June 8, 2024, and Sunday, June 9, 2024, 10am - 4pm

LOCATION: Jim Edgar Panther Creek SFWA (Cass County), 10149 County Hwy 11, Chandlerville, IL 62627

DIRECTIONS: From IL Hwy. 125 approximately 1.75 miles west of Ashland, IL or 3.5 miles east of Philadelphia, IL, turn north on Newmansville Rd. Proceed north on Newmansville Rd. approximately 7 miles to the Jim Edgar Panther Creek SF&WA entrance sign. Turn west at the entrance sign and proceed approximately 1.75 miles to the site headquarters.

LUNCH: Lunch will be provided at no additional cost to all registered clinic participants.

APPAREL: Wear upper garments that do not restrict either side-to-side shoulder movement or up and down arm movement. Upper garments should not have snaps, buckles, buttons, or strap adjustments on the front side of the shooting shoulder. **A cap or hat is required.**

FOOTWEAR: This is a field activity. Wear comfortable but sturdy shoes orboots. No open-toed shoes or sandals.

EYE & EAR PROTECTION: Eye and ear protection are mandatory and will be provided. Students with their own shooting glasses and ear plugs or earmuffs are encouraged to bring them. Students who wear prescription glasses or contact lenses should wear them.

SHOTGUNS: Twenty-eight gauge shotguns with shotshells will be provided. Students with their own shotgun are encouraged to bring the shotgun. If the shotgun has interchangeable chokes, bring the most open choke available (cylinder, skeet, or improved cylinder). **Note: Since shotshells will be provided, students bringing a shotgun must note this on their skill assessment sheet.**

INSTRUCTORS: The clinic will be instructed by National Sporting Clays Association (NSCA) and IDNR Certified Wingshooting Instructors.
