

ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION

1968 BOATING ACCIDENT REPORT

The following information is contained in Boating Accident Reports submitted to this Department on 122 reportable boating accidents during the 1968 boating season, involving 162 boats. There were 56 fatalities, 54 resulting from drownings and 2 from multiple injuries. 80 boaters were injured in these accidents.

Capsized: Child age 8 drowned - wearing no life jacket

Sinking: Child age 8 drowned - wearing no life jacket

Collision with barges: One child age 2 and one age 3 were drowned -  
life jackets on

Capsized: Child age 5 drowned - life jacket on

Capsized: Child age 4 drowned - life jacket on bank

Collision: Child age 3 injured - life jacket worn

Explosion: 2 children injured - life jackets worn

Child age 9 injured by boat while swimming under water
