

## BOATING ACCIDENT REPORT - 1970

The following information is contained in Boating Accident Reports submitted to this Department on 98 reportable boating accidents which occurred during the year 1970, involving 133 boats. There were 38 fatalities, 31 resulting from drowning and 7 from injuries. Injuries to 58 boaters also resulted. Property damage amounted to \$190,828.00. Of the boating accidents reported, only 4 were rental boats. Forty-nine accidents involved one boat; 35 accidents involved two boats; 12 accidents were fires or explosions occurring to anchored boats; and 2 accidents were collisions with anchored or docked boats.

SKIING ACCIDENTS

There were 9 boating accidents related to water skiing, resulting in 14 injuries and 1 casualty:

Cause	Result
Pulling skiers, collision 2 vessels	4 skiers injured
Boat stopped, skier putting on skies, collision	3 skiers injured
Pulling skier, skier lost balance	1 skier injured
Not sure what happened	Skier injured himself
Collision with vessel, operator watching skier	2 skiers injured
Attempting to pick up skier. Passenger sitting on gunnel of boat, fell overboard	1 drowning
Boat pulling skier, operator inexperienced, pushed throttle wrong position, ran over skier	1 injured
Pulling skier, other boat ran over tow rope.	
Skier dragged under tow boat, cut by propeller	1 injured
Ski rope wrapped around neck of skier	1 injured
