BOATING ACCIDENT REPORT - 1975

During the calendar year 1975, there were 126 reportable accidents reported to this office involving 178 boats, Seventy-four (74) accidents involved one boat and fifty-two (52) accidents involved two boats. Property damage amounted to approximately \$154,426.65. Twenty-seven (27) accidents resulted in the drowning of 34 persons, and seven accidents resulted in death, other than by drowning, to nine persons.
