A state law requires that all snowmobilers at least twelve years of age and less than sixteen years of age may operate a snowmobile only if:

- 1. They have in possession a valid Snowmobile Safety Education Certificate of Competency, issued by the Department authorizing them to operate snowmobiles.
- 2. They are accompanied on the snowmobile by a parent or guardian at least 16 years of age.

Students 12 and over successfully completing the course and the final exam will receive an official wallet Certificate of Completion. Students 11 years old will receive their certificate upon their 12th birthday. Students under the age of 11 may not participate in the exam to receive certification.

This is an excellent opportunity for young snowmobilers who need the course in order to operate a snowmobile. It can be beneficial for both beginning and advanced snowmobilers.

The Illinois Snowmobile Safety Course consists of a minimum eight hours of instruction and covers the basics of operator safety, equipment, requirements, registration and titling, emergency measures, responsible operation and the Illinois snowmobile laws.

Pre-registration is required for attendance at the class.
