

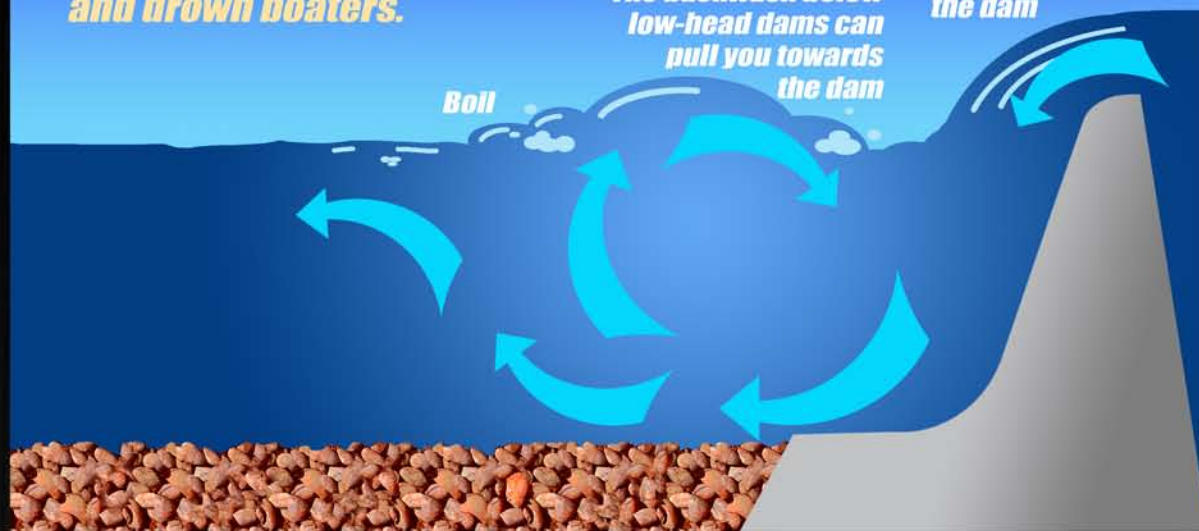
# DANGER DAM!
