## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

### **BOAT DOCK AND ROOF STRUCTURE ON PISTAKEE LAKE IN THE VILLAGE OF FOX LAKE BY HARLAN DOLAND**

Harlan Doland, 525 Circle Drive, Fox Lake, Illinois 60020 has applied for a permit from the IDNR, Office of Water Resources for the construction of a boat dock and roof structure at his residence on Pistakee Lake in the Village of Fox Lake. The property is located west of Route 12, and east of Queens Island. This public notice is being issued pursuant to State rules for the regulation of public waters.

The existing boat dock is comprised of a 50-foot-long main dock, that has a parallel and connecting dock to create a “h”-shape. The total dock system extends 50 feet into the Lake. The applicant proposes to construct a pitched cedar roof structure to cover the boat slip. The roof structure is 12 feet wide and 30 feet long.

The project site is located in the Northeast Quarter of Section 16, Township 45 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian in Lake County. A location map is on the back of this public notice.

Plans for the work may be seen by appointment at the Northeastern Illinois Regulatory Programs Section office, 2050 West Stearns Road, Bartlett, Illinois 60103. Inquiries and requests to review the plans may be directed to Heather McGowan of the Bartlett Office at 847/608-3116.

Review of this project will be limited to the following issues: 1) Any obstruction to, or interference with the navigability of Pistakee Lake; 2) Any encroachment on Pistakee Lake; and 3) Any impairment of the rights, interests or uses of the public on Pistakee Lake or in the natural resources thereof.
