**PUBLIC NOTICE**

**PROPOSED PIPELINE PROTECTION NEAR RM500 ON THE MISSISSIPPI  
RIVER IN ROCK ISLAND COUNTY**

Notice is hereby given to all interested parties that the Illinois Department of Natural Resources, Office of Water Resources (IDNR/OWR) has received an application from ONEOK North System, 100 West 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Tulsa, Oklahoma 74103 to perform pipeline armoring activities near RM 500 on the Mississippi River between Cordova and Port Byron in Rock Island County. A location map is provided on the second page of this notice.

The proposed project involves the placement of 1-inch and 9-inch-thick concrete revetment mats to be placed by divers from barges. The concrete mats will be precast and cured before placement. Riprap will be placed within a 10-foot buffer around the placed mats. The disturbed area of the channel will measure 60 feet across the bank and 649 feet into the channel. Construction is proposed to occur between March and December 1<sup>st</sup> once all permits are received.
