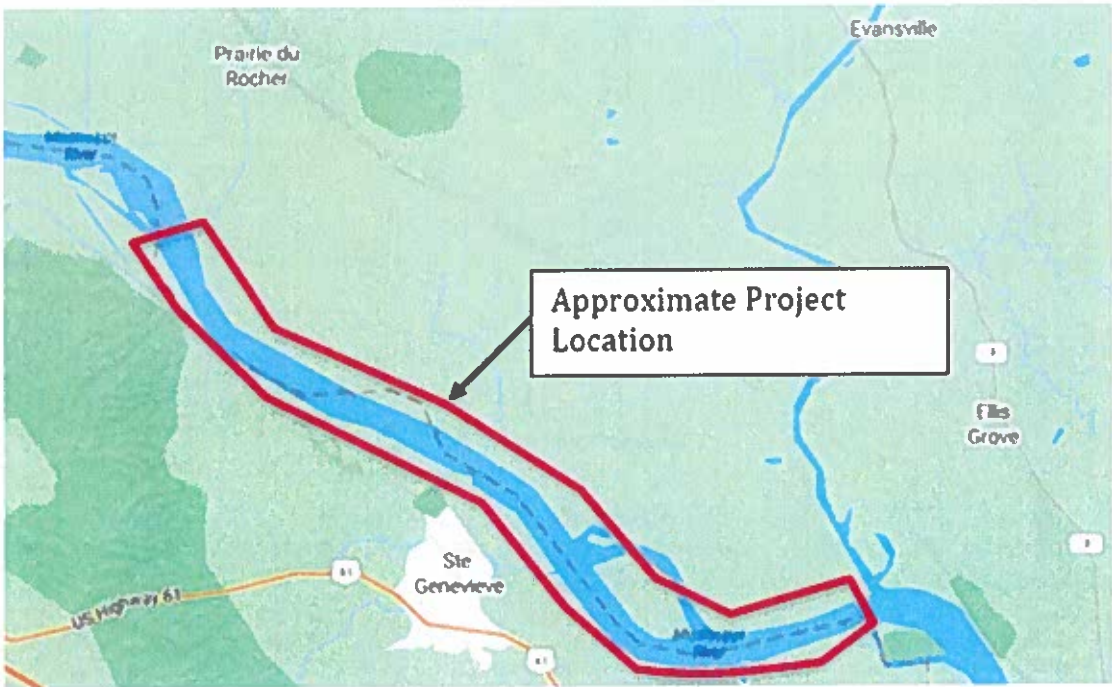
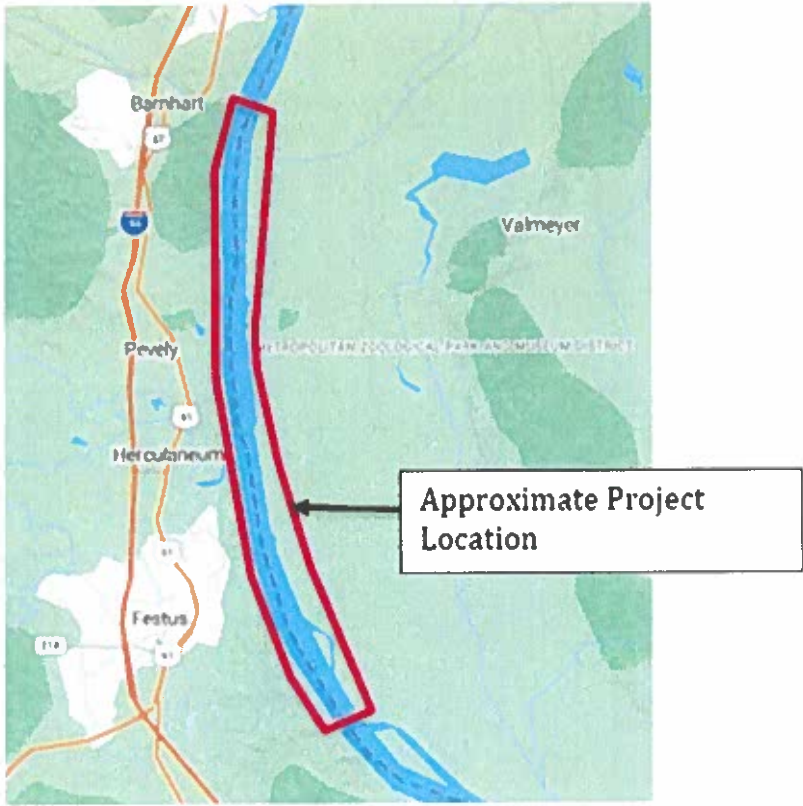
**PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS OF EXISTING STONE DIKE  
STRUCTURES AND CONSTRUCTION OF NEW STONE FEATURES  
IN THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER  
IN MONROE COUNTY AND RANDOLPH COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

Notice is hereby given to all interested parties that the Illinois Department of Natural Resources, Office of Water Resources (IDNR/OWR) has received an application for permit from U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, 1222 Spruce Street, St. Louis, Missouri 63103 to modify stone dike structures and construct new stone features in the Mississippi River.

The portion of the proposed project in Illinois, is located on the Mississippi River approximately between river miles 119 – 130 and 147 – 157. A location map is provided on the second page of this notice.

The proposed project includes degrading and notching existing dikes, constructing revetments, boulder fields, and round point structures.
