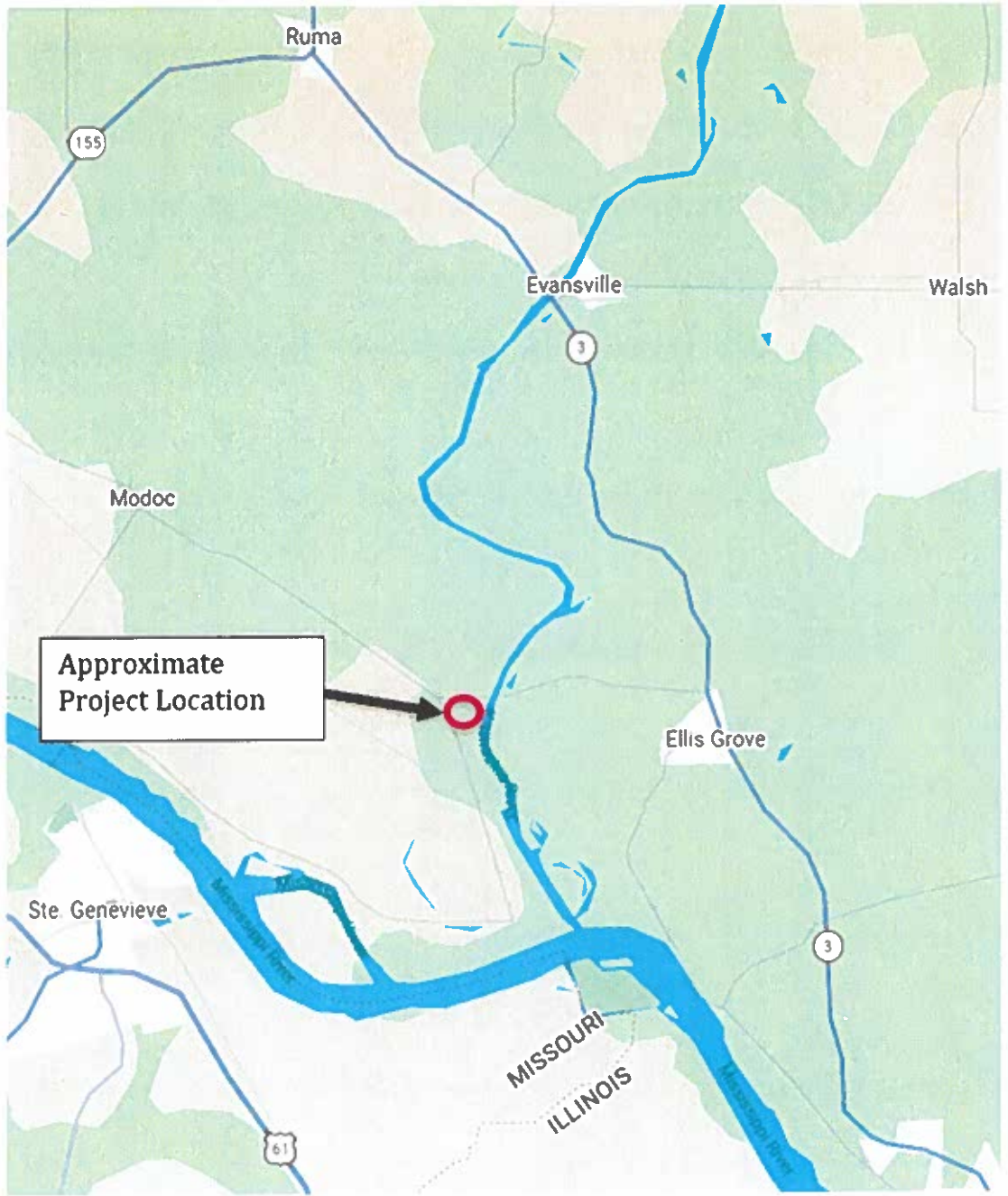
**PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS TO A PUMP STATION AND
ASSOCIATED FEATURES NEAR THE KASKASKIA RIVER IN
RANDOLPH COUNTY**

Notice is hereby given to all interested parties that the Illinois Department of Natural Resources Office of Water Resources (IDNR/OWR) has received an application for permit from the Illinois Department of Natural Resources, One Natural Resources Way, Springfield, Illinois 62702, to modify an existing pump station and associated features.

The proposed project is located at 38.01456° N, 89.96294° W. It is adjacent and to the west of river mile 3 of the Kaskaskia River. The site is approximately 700 ft. south of Roots Road and 1,400 ft. east of Lock and Dam Road in Randolph County, Illinois. A location map is provided on the second page of this notice.

The proposed project includes modifications to the existing pump station building; a new gate structure at the west end of the gravity flow pipes; a new electrical building; modification of the outfall structure on the east side of the existing levee; retaining walls and grade changes on the west side of the existing levee; sediment removal from the existing pump station forebay; re-establishment of forebay channel; and temporary cofferdams on both sides of the existing levee.
