PUBLIC NOTICE

Construction, Operation and Maintenance of Hubler Lake Dam in Marshall County, Illinois

Notice is hereby given to all interested parties that an application has been received from Mohr & Kerr Engineering & Land Surveying, P.C. for a permit authorizing the construction, operation and maintenance of Hubler Lake Dam over an unnamed tributary to Crow Creek. The dam is located approximately 3.5 miles north of Washburn, just west of Illinois Route 89, in southwest quarter of Section 13, Township 29 North, Range 2 West of the 3rd Principal Meridian in Marshall County. Latitude/longitude coordinates for the project are 40.97200, -89.28720. The proposed dam has been provisionally classified as a small-size, Class III dam.

The earthfill dam is proposed to have a maximum height of 38 feet for a final top of dam elevation of 652.7' and top width of 15 feet, with 3:1 (horizontal:vertical) slopes on the upstream and downstream faces. The impoundment will be used for private recreational uses. The pool level will be controlled by a drop inlet spillway that connects to an outlet pipe inside the dam. Riprap is proposed at the outlet of the spillway to protect from erosion. The storage volume of the impoundment at full capacity is approximately 41.8 acre-feet.

All interested parties are invited to submit written comments regarding the proposed work to the above address by October 4, 2024. You are herein provided, per the State of Illinois "Rules for Construction and Maintenance of Dams" (17 IAC CH. I, Section 3702), opportunity to request a hearing regarding the classification. Any request for such classification hearing must be in writing and include sufficient information to establish the degree of threat to life and property damage in the event of a dam failure.
