
PUBLIC NOTICE

FLOATING DOCK AND GANGWAY ON THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER AT RIVER MILE 503.5 NEAR THE VILLAGE OF CORDOVA IN ROCK ISLAND COUNTY

Notice is hereby given to all interested parties that the Illinois Department of Natural Resources, Office of Water Resources (IDNR/OWR) has received an application for permit from John Damgaard, 1424 Lake Knoll Drive, Lake Saint Louis, Missouri 63367 to construct a floating dock and gangway on the Mississippi River in the northwest quarter of section 31, township 20 North, range 2 East of the 4th Principal Meridian in Rock Island County. A location map is provided on the second page of this notice.

The submitted application, plans and correspondence indicate that the applicant has constructed a floating dock and gangway on the right descending bank of the Mississippi River. The floating dock will have outer dimensions of 36ft by 24ft and feature a peaked roof over an internal boat slip. The dock will be anchored to the top of bank by way of a gangway measuring 75ft by 4ft4in. The applicant indicates that the dock is seasonal and removed each year to avoid river ice.
